The Royal Livingstone Livingstone, Victoria Falls

Located on the forested banks of the Zambezi River, in the heart of the Mosi-Oa-Tunya National Wildlife Park, The Five star Royal Livingstone looks directly out over the Zambezi to where the mighty river cascades into the Batoka Gorge at the point known as the Mosi-Oa-Tunya, the smoke that thunders, Victoria Falls.

The Royal Livingstone is certainly the grandest of all the hotels in Livingstone. The main areas are spacious and have an elegant colonial feel to them, especially in the bar and lounge areas. The luxurious 175 rooms, split between 17 buildings, come complete with satellite tv's, luxurious ensuite bathrooms and sumptuous fabrics. Many rooms have superb views directly out onto the Zambezi.

With Zebra and giraffe roaming around the gardens, and regularly round the hotels swimming pool, nature is right on your doorstep. The great location right by the falls provides the best access to the areas activities. The food and service is what is to be expected of the Sun International chain with fabulous breakfasts and excellent a la carte dining on offer. There is nowhere better to watch the sun go down than at the hotels sun deck cocktail bar on the rivers edge.

Guest Relations or the Daily Activity Centre is your ticket to micro light or helicopter flights over the Falls, white water rafting, elephant back safaris, river cruises and a variety of heart-stopping activities, such as leaping headlong of bridges and cliffs, but to name a few.
